

# UT Dallas Snapshot

- Fall 2015 Enrollment: 24,532
- Campus Residents: 4,700
- Full Time: 77%
- Part Time: 23%
- Undergraduate: 63%
- Graduate: 37%
- 84% of Degrees Conferred are in Science, Engineering and Business disciplines
- Very High Quality Students
  - SAT Score (1257) – Among Best of Texas Public Universities


# Enrollment Trends





# Student-Athlete Successes



- Twelve of UTD's 13 intercollegiate athletic programs qualified for the *American Southwest Conference's* post-season championship tournaments

- Comet Cab – serves the interior of the campus
  - Annual ridership last year of 148,000
  - This year ridership has already surpassed 140,000
- Comet Cruiser – bus service
  - Annual ridership last year of over 1.2 million
  - Will surpass 1.2 million this year
