





Revised South Building Elevation







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



CityLine East Amendment Summary

Building Design Standards (Tract 2)

Applies to: **Arts, entertainment and recreation uses, exclusively**

Windows Area:

North facade (facing Civic Open Space)

50% required / **5% proposed** – *interior theater space*

West facade (facing Wilshire Way, Type A)

50% required / **30% proposed** – *interior lobby space*

South facade (facing Hunt Street, Type B)

15% required / **0% proposed** – *interior theater space &
“back door” operations*

Façade Rhythm (Type A Streets):


20' – 40' on Wilshire Way / **Waive requirement** – *unique design*

Building Materials:

85% masonry, stucco, pre-cast, glass curtain wall


15% wood, metal, tile, CMU / **85% Architectural metal panel**

- 47% transparent storefront windows provided on ground floor when measured to 25' height
- 42% transparent storefront windows provided on ground floor for overall wall height

Surface Parking (Tract 3)

- Allowed as a primary use
- No time limit
- Concrete construction required
- Pedestrian accommodation required with adjacent street construction per Section 9 of Code
- Screening required with adjacent street construction per Section 7.2.6 of Code

CityLine East Amendment Summary


Temporary Parking (Tract 1)

- May be constructed of asphalt
- Maximum of three (3) temporary allowed at one time
- Maximum 500 spaces per lot
- May only be constructed to provide parking for existing parking spaces being disturbed or removed as a consequence of future development
- May remain in use for 42 months or 6 months following issuance of C.O. for the use associated with the permanent replacement spaces


