Agenda Item:	Review and Discuss the Status of the Dumont Drive Traffic Calming Study
Staff Resource:	Dave Carter, Assistant Director
Summary:	<p>In 2008, City Council approved the Traffic Calming Policy for Residential Neighborhoods, which defines the process and requirements for implementing measures to control speeding and/or traffic volumes on residential streets.</p> <p>To date, Dumont Drive is the only residential street that has met all the requirements of the policy for a trial implementation of speed cushions.</p> <p>Speed cushions were installed in May/June 2013. The traffic studies indicate that the speed cushions were effective in calming traffic because both travel speeds and traffic volumes have dropped along Dumont.</p> <p>In accordance with the policy, notices were mailed to all property owners within the primary affected area that included a mail-back ballot to indicate their preference on the speed cushions remaining.</p> <p>Staff will present the final results of the trial implementation and study results.</p>
